

UAMS PGY2 Pharmacy Residency Program in Ambulatory Care

Number of Positions: 2 (1 in Little Rock, 1 in Fayetteville)

Background and Special Features

The PGY2 Ambulatory Care Pharmacy Practice Residency through the University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences (UAMS) College of Pharmacy provides the resident with diverse learning opportunities in the field of ambulatory care pharmacotherapy and academia, with a goal of preparing the resident for independent practice in a variety of settings. Experiences range from an interprofessional, student-led, free health clinic

to community-based primary care clinics to traditional specialty practices on the UAMS campuses of Little Rock and Fayetteville. The resident will precept pharmacy students and work directly with students and residents from several other health professions. The resident will also complete the UAMS College of Pharmacy Teaching Certificate and the Research Certificate Programs.

Application Process

Eligibility

Applicants must have a Pharm.D. degree from an ACPE-accredited school of pharmacy, have completed or be in the process of completing a PGY1 pharmacy residency (ASHP-accredited or candidate status), be eligible for Arkansas licensure, and be willing to participate in an interview. The PGY2 Ambulatory Care Pharmacy Residency is accredited by ASHP and is participating in the ASHP Match.

Applicants must submit the following documents via PhORCAS by January 5:

- Pharmacy school transcript
- Curriculum vitae
- Letter of intent
- 3 Letters of recommendation
